*National Concerns in Regards to Short-term Rentals:

- *Colorado Association of Ski Towns Vacation Home Rentals Issues, Emerging Trends and Best Practices, Published June 2015.
- Loss of long term rentals
- Impacts on Workforce Housing conversion into VHR's
- Neighborhood impact: changing the character
- Large cities San Francisco, Denver, New York getting aggressive with managing VHR's - tax collection – specific zone areas only
- Impacts on small towns and Colorado ski towns lack of housing, changing character of town, impact on residents

<u>Impacts of Short-term Rentals on the Town of Minturn</u>

- 1) Regulating short term rentals VHR's (vacation home rentals)
 - Business License
 - Permit
 - Property Manager that lives in Eagle County
 - Lodging Tax
 - > Building Code Safety Inspections (fire alarms, CO2 registers, other?)
- 2) Zoning of short term rentals VHR's
 - Do they need to be in a commercial or mixed-use zone?
 - Does the property owner need to have owned the home for 2 or more years before a short term rental business license can be issued? (protect brokers buying long term housing for investment speculation)
 - Restrict the number and location of VHR's in town

- 3) Managing short term rentals Code Enforcement
 - Displaces locals turns neighborhoods into lodging districts
 - Neighborhood impacts: trash, too many occupants, parties, noise
 - Parking
 - Snow Removal
 - Dogs
 - 3 Strikes Policy
- 4) Other
