

**TOWN OF MINTURN
RESOLUTION 14 – SERIES 2010**

A RESOLUTION SETTING BALLOT LANGUAGE FOR A VOTER QUESTION OF WHETHER THE OPERATION AND LICENSING OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTERS, OPTIONAL PREMISES CULTIVATION OPERATIONS, AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCTS MANUFACTURERS SHALL BE PROHIBITED IN THE TOWN OF MINTURN ON THE NOVEMBER 2, 2010 EAGLE COUNTY COORDINATED ELECTION AND PROVIDING OTHER DETAILS RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Minturn, in the County of Eagle and State of Colorado (the "Town"), is a home rule municipal corporation duly organized and existing under laws of the State of Colorado and the Town Charter (the "Charter"); and

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council of the Town (the "Council") have been duly elected and qualified; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article II, Section 2.1 of the Charter and Section 31-10-102.7, C.R.S., the Town may provide by resolution that it will utilize the requirements and procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992 in lieu of the Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965 with respect to any election; and

WHEREAS, in the November 2000 general election, the voters of the State of Colorado adopted Amendment 20 to the Colorado Constitution ("Article XVIII Section 14") which authorizes and limits the sale of medical marijuana for use in the treatment of debilitating medical conditions; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 10-1284 further authorizes a municipality by either a majority of registered electors of the municipality voting at a regular election or a majority of the members of the governing board for the municipality to vote to prohibit the operation of medical marijuana centers, optional premises cultivation operations, and medical marijuana-infused products manufacturers' licenses; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to take advantage of the local option provided for in House Bill 10-1284, by presenting to the registered electorate of the Town of Minturn at the County Coordinated election on November 2, 2010, the question of whether to prohibit the operation of medical marijuana centers, optional premises cultivation operations, and medical marijuana-infused products manufacturers' licenses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MINTURN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The following question shall be submitted to a vote of the registered electorate
