

**TOWN OF MINTURN, COLORADO
RESOLUTION NO. 25 – SERIES 2018**

**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING BALLOT ISSUE 2A – CONCERNING THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONSTRUCTION USE TAX IN MINTURN**

WHEREAS, the Minturn Town Council has submitted to the registered, qualified electors of the Town of Minturn, at the general election to be held on November 6, 2018, a question authorizing the Town of Minturn the authority to levy a 4% Construction Use Tax on all construction materials purchased for use within the Town boundaries; and

WHEREAS, currently construction products purchased out of town for use in town are assessed a sales tax in the local entity where the purchase is conducted; and

WHEREAS, ballot measure 2A will assess a use tax paid to Minturn in place of a sales tax paid to the entity of purchase; and

WHEREAS, a Minturn Construction Use Tax will not apply to the first \$10,000 of project value and will only benefit Capital Improvement projects within the Town of Minturn; and

WHEREAS, Minturn's great need for capital funding is apparent in our potholed streets, our crumbling or nonexistent sidewalks, our lack of recreational spaces, and our aging bridges and buildings; and

WHEREAS, over half of Colorado's communities have passed construction use taxes including local towns like Vail, Eagle, Gypsum, and Red Cliff; and

WHEREAS, passage of ballot measure 2A will help Minturn pay for critical infrastructure essential to a vibrant community which will enhance the quality of life for all Minturn Citizens and Visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees for the Town of Minturn desire to support the Town of Minturn's efforts in this regard and encourage our constituents to vote yes on Ballot Issue 2A; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF MINTURN, COLORADO:**

That, the Town Council of the Town of Minturn, Colorado that we affirmatively support Minturn ballot issue 2A, and further demonstrate our support by approving this Resolution.


That, the registered, qualified electors of Minturn are encouraged to vote YES on Ballot Issue 2A.
